## NEW SCHOOL PROJECT

This last year, being in classroom bubbles, made us more aware of how valuable and precious our outdoor space is. I wanted to share with you some of the projects we have developed for your children.

- We used our sports premium funding this year to purchase a multi use games area for the KS2 children.
- As well as continuing to develop our forest school area we have now designed a 'Westfield Orchard' area towards the back of the school. This includes a successful bid for 14 fruit trees from 'The Tree Council' and a donation of extra fruit trees from the PTA.
- Before lockdown we created a vegetable garden (remember the huge pumpkin) and this has been 'restocked' by Craig our gardener. The children will be involved in the growing and harvesting.

Taking the classroom outside is one of my biggest passions. The benefits of outdoor learning are huge and include, connecting with nature, appreciation of natural surroundings, providing practical experiences alongside improved health, attainment and behaviour. We have an area of space on the school grounds which lends itself to becoming an excellent spot for an outdoor classroom. Clearly this comes with a cost and the funds will be raised by our school community. I have set a goal of 12 months to raise the money and have an amazing facility built on our grounds.
